SERMON: “THE VIP IN MY LIFE”

Proverbs 31

- A. This weekend we want to focus on an individual who is probably more of a VIP in your life than she even knows. She isn't on the cover of a magazine, and probably wasn't on the party list for the Grammy's, or CMEA Awards, or the Barnstable Brown Party list for the VIP's who attended the Kentucky Derby. But in your eyes, as a son or daughter, she's a VIP. Her name is MOM.
- B. Today I want to thank moms for three expressions that they show to their children.
1. Moms **INSTILL** respect for authority.
 - A. Proverbs 29:17
 - B. Proverbs 31:26
 2. Moms are **INVOLVED** in the lives of their children.
 - A. 2 Timothy 1:15
 - B. Proverbs 31: 13, 16, 17, 19, 20, 22, 24
 - C. Deuteronomy 6:5-9
 3. Moms **TRUST** God through those uncertain times.
 - A. Proverbs 22:6
 - B. 3 John 4

CONCLUSION:

Whether you are a mom or not, whether you are a guy or a gal, it doesn't matter because whomever you are in Christ's eyes, each one of you here today is a Very Important Person. And if He didn't feel that way, then He wouldn't have died for you. But He did. Romans 5:8 says, “While we were still sins, Christ died for us.”
