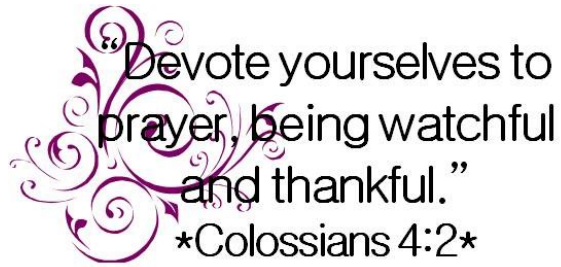

2024 THEME: PEOPLE OF THE TRUTH

KNOW THE TRUTH! GROW THE TRUTH! GO SHARE THE TRUTH!

John 8:31-32 says "If you hold to my teaching, you are really my disciples. Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free."

THEME: "LIVING A LIFE OF INTEGRITY" -

SERMON: "REFUSE TO WORRY" - Matthew 6:25-34

- A. "Don't Worry, Be Happy." When you hear that tune, it immediately brings a smile to your face. In your mind it conjures up an image of a carefree Jamaican man who is at ease and stress free. To him life is simply a vacation. There is no stress, no concerns, no bills to pay, no children to shuttle from event to event, no sickness to battle, and no problems to solve. Don't worry—be happy!
- B. We wish it were only that simple right? It's been said that, "Many of us are worry-a-holics". We stew. We obsess. We gnaw on our nails. We twirl our hair. We toss and turn in bed. We sip Maalox. And we sneak Valium."
Each anxiety is like a hyperactive dog in a fenced backyard madly racing around and around.
- C. Jesus doesn't want you to worry your life away. He wants you to cast your worries upon Him because He cares for you.
- D. So this morning we are going to take a look at nine verses that will help us to release our worries over to Jesus, so that He can minister to us, and help us work through them.
1. First He gives us a **REQUIREMENT**. "Don't worry."
 - A. Matthew 6:25
 - B. Philippians 4:6-7
 - C. 1 Peter 5:7
 - D. Ecclesiastes 11:10
 - E. Matthew 6:26-27
 2. Secondly He gives us five different **REASONS** why we shouldn't worry.
 - A. Worry accomplishes nothing.
 - B. Worry reveals a lack of faith.
 - C. Worry affects relationships.
 - D. Worry damages your health.
 - E. Worry hinders your witness.
 1. Titus 2:10
 2. Matthew 6:28-31
 3. Matthew 6:31
 4. Ecclesiastes 2:11
 3. Thirdly Jesus gives us a **REMEDY** for worry.
 - A. Matthew 6:33-34
 - B. I believe Jesus Christ gives us a three step remedy for overcoming worry.
 1. Focus on the eternal not the temporary.
 - a. Luke 10:41
 2. Live one day at a time.
 3. Trust the truth that your Heavenly Father is in control.
 - a. Jesus says, "Do not worry, your Heavenly Father knows what you need and will take care of it. He will feed you, He will cloth you, and He will guide you."

CONCLUSION: Word to "His Eye Is On The Sparrow." Maybe you want to move from worry to trust. "His eye is on the sparrow" but more importantly, His eye is on you. It starts by placing your trust in Him. If you have a decision to make or maybe you want to make this your church home, you meet me down front as we stand and sing.
