



THEME: A YEAR FOR UNDERSTANDING - 1 Kings 3:9
"Give to your servant an understanding heart."
SERIES: THIS IS MY NEW LIFE
SERMON: THE LIFE WE LIVE

- A. Now if you weren't here last week, you need to know that the Book of Ruth actually shares with us the story of a woman named Naomi. Naomi is married to a man name Elimelek, and Elimelek passes away while they are living outside of Bethlehem during a time of famine. But Naomi still has two sons and her two sons marry women from Moab. So they marry outside of the Jewish faith, and they marry girls who worship a lot of gods or idols rather than the one true God. But after several years, both of Naomi's sons pass away, and so now we have Naomi with two daughters-in-law. She decides to go back to Bethlehem, and she urges her two daughters-in-law to go back to their own families in Moab. But one of them, Ruth, says "No, where you go, I will go. Where you stay, I will stay. Your people, will be my people, and your God, will be my God." She basically changes her spiritual beliefs, and now she is going to follow the one true God: the God of Jacob, the God of Abraham, the God whom we worship.
- B. Now we're going to pick up the story in Ruth chapter 2, and when we do, we're going to find that Ruth has come back with Naomi, where she doesn't know anyone. This is a whole new life for Ruth and she is gonna have to find a way to make a living so that she and Naomi will have food to eat. So our goal for today is to learn that when we make wise choices on a daily basis, God will someday reward. It might be soon, it might be later, or it might be in the next life. But God will reward our faithfulness.

So there are three different challenges that I see in this section of the Book of Ruth.

- 1. Challenge #1: Be **faithful** where you are. (Or bloom where you're planted.)
 - A. Ruth 2:1-3
 - 1. Leviticus 19:9-10
 - B. Ruth 2:4-5
- 2. Challenge #2: **Look** for God in the ordinary.
 - A. Ruth 2:19-20
 - 1. "The law of the kinsman-redeemer," or "of the guardian-redeemer." Deuteronomy 25 and Leviticus 25.
 - B. Colossians 3:23-24
- 3. Challenge #3: Be **patient** while God unfolds His will.
 - A. Ruth 3:2-5
 - B. Ruth 3:10-12
 - C. Ruth 3:13-17
 - D. Ruth 3:18
 - 1. Philippians 1:6
 - E. Ruth 4:1-6

CONCLUSION: Next week we will learn some important implications that come out of Ruth and Boaz's marriage. You see, their marriage, in a way, will change everything for you and me.


